

Artistry is the new name for Bloomington Theatre and Art Center, which rebranded on July 1, 2015. Artistry is an independent, nonprofit *organization* based in the city-owned *venue* called the Bloomington Center for the Arts. The Bloomington Center for the Arts is home to seven nonprofit arts organizations and also presents outside acts. Artistry's programming comprises theater productions (formerly produced under the name Bloomington Civic Theatre), visual arts exhibitions, arts education at the Center for the Arts and other locations throughout the Twin Cities, and creative placemaking. The following program/organization names are no longer active and should not be used in reference to our programming: Bloomington Art Center, Bloomington Civic Theatre, Bloomington Theatre and Art Center.

This Tony and Drama Desk Award winner has been described as "an original play of superior quality by a playwright who knows his craft and has an unusual understanding of the tangled loyalties of human beings" (New York Times). Human and social conflict are examined in this stirring drama based on a true story. When an industrialist commits a crime during World War II and frames his business partner, his sin comes back to haunt him years later.
